- Submit a Jamboree medical form
- Be approved by your Scoutmaster
- Have at least 2 **complete** Class A uniforms

Financial Details: Reserve your place now with a \$100 application non-refundable deposit.

*The total estimated cost is \$2,250. This fee includes transportation, meals and lodging en route to and from the Jamboree, special patches, patrol and troop equipment, Jamboree training weekend, and a sight seeing trip around Washington D.C. (like the Smithsonian, Washington Memorial, US Capitol, and various other sites. A payment schedule will be announced with installments due at specific dates. When Scouts send in application and \$100 deposit, they should also go online to www.MyScouting.org and apply on the national website with a \$10 online payment. *Exact cost is variable due to plane ticket charges.
